HU-Planning a Safe Return to Hockey

For the 2022-2023 season, bench staff are still required to have completed HU-Planning a Safe Return to Hockey. If you have completed this course previously, you are not required to complete again at this time.

This free 1-hour course offers an overview of Hockey Canada's Return to Hockey Safety Guidelines as part of the Covid-19 response. The program looks at some key information our membership needs to know to help reduce the risk of COVID-19 in the hockey environment. It encourages all members to become familiar with the Public Health Authority guidelines and restrictions and the Hockey Canada Safety Guidelines.

To complete this course:

- Please ensure you have a Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) account set up before completing the course <u>HCR 3.0 Hockey Canada Registry</u>.
